

Important Information for Interim Federal Health Program (IFHP) Health-Care Providers

Update to the Reimbursement Policy Prescription Drug Program – Saskatchewan

November 2018

This bulletin is to inform you that Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) has implemented a change to the IFHP Prescription Drug Program (i.e. Dispensing Fee – see below description) specific to Saskatchewan, effective November 1, 2018.

Description	Reimbursement Policy – IRCC (IFHP)
Dispensing Fee (regular)	\$11.60
Dispensing Fee (Compounded Products, all)	\$17.40 (150% of the dispensing fee for regular products)
Dispensing Fee - Urine testing agents, diabetic strips and diabetic supplies	50% of the cost

The mark-up fees (based on product cost):

- \$0.00 \$6.30 = 30%
- \$6.31 \$15.80 = 15%
- > \$15.81 = 10% (maximum of \$20.00 for product cost higher than \$200.00)
